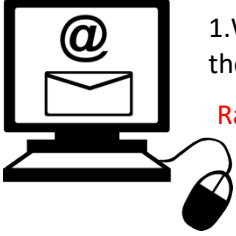

His life

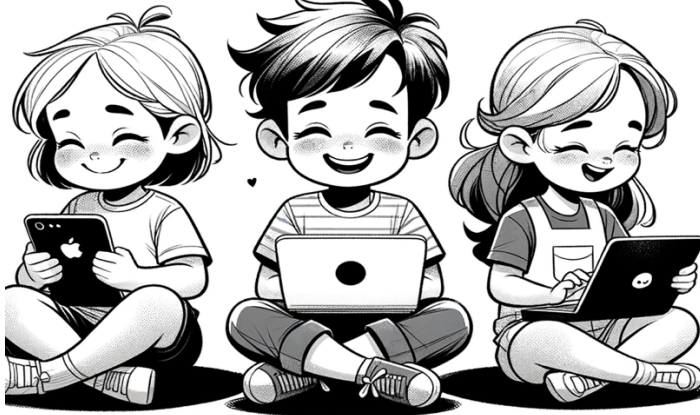
