Easy Chocolate Pudding

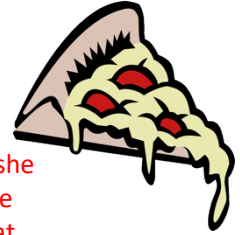


1. First, Get Ingredients: You need milk, sugar, cocoa powder, cornstarch, and chocolate chips.
2. Second, Mix Dry Ingredients: In a bowl, put 2 tablespoons of cocoa powder, 2 tablespoons of sugar, and 1 tablespoon of cornstarch. Mix them.
3. Third, Heat Milk: Pour 2 cups of milk into a pot. Warm it on the stove, but don't boil.
4. Then, Add Dry Mix: Put the dry mix into the milk. Stir it well.
5. Cook: Cook on medium heat. Stir until it is thick.
6. Next, Add Chocolate: Turn off the heat. Add 1/2 cup of chocolate chips. Stir until smooth.
7. Finally, Cool: Pour the pudding into bowls. Let it cool.
8. Enjoy: When it's cool, eat and enjoy!

1. **What are the main ingredients needed for this chocolate pudding recipe?** ingredients are milk, sugar, cocoa powder, cornstarch, and chocolate chips.
2. **What is the first step in making the chocolate pudding?** The answer should mention gathering all the necessary ingredients.
3. **How do you prepare the dry mix for the pudding?** This question refers to the step of mixing cocoa powder, sugar, and cornstarch in a bowl.
4. **What should you do after heating the milk?** This is about adding the dry mix to the heated milk and stirring well.
5. **What is the final step before the pudding is ready to be eaten?** This question refers to pouring the pudding into bowls and letting it cool.

2- There is something wrong about this pizza because my sister confused the order in the recipe. Find the which step is wrong and write your answer. (20p) E8.3.R1. Students will be able to understand the overall meaning of short texts about a process.

You need pizza dough, tomato sauce, cheese, and toppings like mushrooms, peppers, and onions. First, make a round shape. Second, add Sauce: Spread tomato sauce on the dough. Next, add Cheese: Sprinkle cheese over the sauce. Then, add Toppings: Put your favorite toppings like mushrooms, peppers, and onions on the cheese. After that, roll out the pizza dough on a flat surface. Finally, Cook the Pizza: Put the pizza in the oven. Cook it at 200 degrees

Long ago, people talked face to face because they had no phones. To send messages far, they used letters. They wrote on paper, put it in an envelope, and gave it to a postman. The postman took the letter to the other person. This took many days. Then, a big change happened. The telephone was made. Now, people could talk to each other from far away places.
